



In-SPA-rations



MASSAGES

Full-body massages work on underlying muscular structure, stretching tight muscles and easing away tension knots and stiffness in the joints. Adding specialty elements such as an aromatherapy blend of essential oils will aid in healing, beautifying and soothing the skin. Stone therapy massage is very popular for even deeper muscle relaxation. Lava stones heated in water are strategically placed along the body pressure points to warm the muscles and ease tension.

Treatment length: one hour or more

Results enjoyed: two-plus weeks

Cost: \$65-\$95 for basic massage

\$95-\$135 for specialty massage

FACIALS

Facials are designed to deep-cleanse, exfoliate, tone, hydrate and massage the face, neck and décolleté skin. All skin types benefit from a facial treatment, as every facial is customized to an individual's skin type, sensitivity and condition. The application depends on the spa's philosophy and esthetician training. Techniques range from completely hands on to machines using micro-current electricity and micodermabrasion to chemical peels.

Treatment length: one hour average

Results: three to four weeks

Cost: \$75-\$150

BODY POLISHING

The body is bathed in a purifying, scented scrub combination of salts, sugar and other exfoliation ingredients that gently remove dead skin cells, detoxify and reveal new revitalized skin. This treatment is a wonderful way to begin a massage or body wrap, because the new skin will more effectively absorb the nutrients from spa treatments that follow.

Treatment length: 45 minutes

Results: two to three weeks

Cost: \$85-\$120

PEDICURES

Spa pedicures clean, repair and hydrate the feet and nails. After feet are soaked in an anti-bacterial foot bath, a gentle exfoliating product removes dead, calloused, dry skin from the knee down, to allow absorption

WAXING

While not a glamorous-sounding treatment, waxing is priceless to those in need of a little extra help in removing excess hair. Using a combination of hot and cold wax, based on the area treated, waxing removes the hair from the root, allowing the area to be hair-free for up to four weeks — a gift in itself.

Treatment length: 15 to 45 minutes

Results: three to four weeks

Cost: \$15-\$85
